* Benefits (Fee-Paying Students Only)

1 Early Bird Reward

All students who successfully register by October 14 (Fri) and make a full tuition fee by October 28 (Fri) will get a discount of 200,000 KRW per course.

The Early Course Registration chance will be exclusively given to the Early Bird Reward recipients.

APRU & AEARU Associate University Scholarship (100,000 KRW)

All students who are enrolled in the APRU and AEARU associate university will receive the APRU & AEARU scholarship and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.

3 Re-Enrollment Benefit (100,000 KRW)

All students who have aprticipated in the YISS or WAY program in the past are eligible to receive a fee benefit and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.

4 Yonsei Alumni Scholarship (200,000 KRW)

All students whose parents are graduate of Yonsei University are elibible to the Yonsei Alumni Scholarship.

*** Payment Method**

- 1 International/Domestic Wire Transfer: Wire transfer information will be provided by email after the online application is submitted.
- 2 Flywire: Credit/Debit card payment and other payment services (paypal, etc) are provided. Cards that are issued overseas are accepted only (Visa, Master and JCB).

*** Housing (Optional)**

Because on-campus housing is not guaranteed for all students due to the limited availability, housing is allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. Students are strongly recommended to apply for housing as soon as possible through the housing website <u>dorm.yonsei.ac.kr/en</u> after receiving your acceptance email.



Yonsei University is located in the center of the capital city of South Korea, Seoul, where you can witness a variety of traditional Korean culture. In addition to Korea's first Western health institution, Gwanghyewon which is located within the university, there are other nearby sites where you can experience traces of the 500-year history of the Joseon Dynasty, such as Deoksu-gung, Changdeokgung, and Gyeongbok-gung. These sites are located only 15 minutes away from campus so that students may easily seek out these opportunities to experience Korea's traditional culture.
